Exhibitors must cover space provided (and any backdrop) with black cloth or similar material.

Prints either 6"x4" or 7"x5" (Not shown previously)

Cookery

- 56 Jar of Chutney
- 57 Jar of Jam (Any Variety)
- 58 Victoria Sponge - to our recipe: -
6oz (168gm) butter
6oz (168gm) castor sugar
6oz (168gm) self raising flour
3 eggs
1-2 tablespoons warm water
To fill - a little jam
To decorate - a little sugar
2 x 7" sandwich tins
OVEN 375°F, 190°C, Reg 5, near top
25-30 mins (ovens may vary)

- 60 5 Fruit Scones

Wine

Home made fruit or vegetable wine (NO KITS or CONCENTRATES) to be presented in clear wine bottles with flanged cork. Labelled clearly with main ingredient and whether sweet or dry, using a small label placed about 1" above base of bottle.
